The Vision Study is an initial step in evaluating the airport's land use designations for improved compatibility with the surrounding community. The Vision Study will develop a report that will incorporate new technology that further embraces sustainability, enhances airport facilities, strengthens VNY as a regional jobs base, and increases access and diversity in aviation.

Did you know?

The VNY Airport Plan was adopted in 2006 as a 20-year plan by the Los Angeles City Council to guide land use development at the airport. As 2026 approaches, LAWA, as the airport owner, is engaging with surrounding communities, stakeholders, and technical experts to create a comprehensive land use vision over the next 20 years for continued operations of VNY as a general aviation airport.
