

REDESIGN OF RNAV DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

Van Nuys Airport (VNY) implemented redesigned departure procedures on February 20, 2025. This important update addresses noise concerns that have affected hillside communities since the FAA's 2017 Metroplex implementation.

The revised Area Navigation (RNAV) departure procedures will restore flight paths closer to their original alignment, providing welcome relief to Valley residents. This achievement is the result of years of persistent effort among LAWA, the FAA, and local elected officials, following recommendations from the Southern San Fernando Valley Airplane Noise Task Force.

The airport will continue monitoring data and engaging with residents to ensure ongoing improvements to our community's quality of life while supporting VNY's vital role in regional transportation. For more information, click <u>here</u>.
